Here are a few men and women who have had an impact shaping U.S. history and improving the lives of American citizens!

- Italian-Americans have fought in every U.S. war, including more than 1.2 million in World War II
- U.S. Senators John Barrasso and Michael B. Enzi represent the state of Wyoming, making this the first time in history that a state is represented by two Italian-Americans
- Mother Frances Cabrini founded 14 American colleges and 98 schools across the country
- In 1904, Amadeo Giannini established the Bank of America, the largest bank in the United States
- In 1971, Leonard Riggio founded one of America's largest book store chains, Barnes & Noble
- Renato Dulbecco received the Nobel Prize for his work in the discovery of DNA
